## Green Bond Criteria: Mitigation

To increase country's energy access using renewable energy

## Expected Results include:

- 4,400 rural households receive electricity from renewable sources which facilitate new beneficial social/productive activities.
- 241,000 tons of CO<sub>2</sub>eq. emissions reduced

## Country Challenge

The objective is to increase electricity access in the poorest southern states of Mexico targeting small communities in the range of 50 to 500 households.

## Project Goals

The project supports use of renewable energy, mainly photovoltaic (solar) systems and some wind generators together with the regulatory and technical support needed to develop a sustainable market for provision of energy services in remote rural areas.
